Minutes

Councilman Snyder asked if everyone had a chance to review the minutes from the prior meeting. Councilman Sprenkle made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Councilman Harper. All others in favor, minutes accepted.

Rodney Smith passed away on Wednesday January 29th. Mr. Smith was recognized in 2022 via resolution for 32 years of continual service as the EMA director for the Borough. In reality Mr. Smith's volunteerism went beyond 32 years. In reality Mr. Smith served over 62 years in service in one capacity or another. Rodney served as a Yoe Borough Fire Fighter,

Police Officer, and Constable. The Council took a moment of silence in remembrance of Rodney and his lifetime of service and dedication to others.

Visitor's Report

Scott Henry, Deputy Fire Chief for SAFER was in attendance to see if the Borough have any questions. Councilman Noll asked if any additional departments would be joining SAFER? Deputy Henry said there has been some discussion with the York Township Fire Department, but this is still in the very early stages.

Engineer's Report

Report provided. Mr. Kraft had a Sanitary Sewer Maintenance agreement from the PA Sewer Authority for cleaning and cameraing. Discussion continued. Some changes need to be made to the agreement, such as verbiage clearly stating work not to exceed \$12,500. Councilman Bankoske made a motion to conditionally approve the contract with the PA Sewer Authority based on title blocks and clarification on verbiage. Seconded by Councilman Sprenkle. All in favor, motion carried.

Mr. Kraft will work with Councilman Claycomb to come up with the next five year plan for roads. We are still waiting on hearing back regarding a few grants. Councilman Noll made a motion for C.S. Davidson to start working on the multi-modal grant application for roadwork. Seconded by Councilman Harper. All in favor, motion carried.

Sewer Billing Report

Residents are not happy with the Sewer and garbage increase. No one is receiving a kickback because of this increase.

Solicitor's Report

No updates on Elm Street.

Resolution 2025-02 SAFER resolution allowing SAFER to secure a temporary liquor license from the PLCB. Councilman Sprenkle made a motion to resolve, seconded by Councilman Claycomb. Councilman Noll abstained, all others in favor. So be it resolved. Based on the adoption of 2025-02 Councilman Claycomb made a motion for the Secretary to send a letter of intent to the County notifying them of the event. Seconded by Councilman Sprenkle.
