Minutes

Councilman Snyder asked if everyone had a chance to review the minutes from the prior meeting. Councilman Sprenkle made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Councilman Bankoske. Councilman Snyder abstained. All others in favor, minutes accepted.

Visitor's Report

Tim Ward was in attendance to be appointed to Council later in the meeting.

Engineer's Report

Report provided. G. Rexroth's engineer had requested a site meeting. Is Council interested in meeting? Discussion continued. Councilman Snyder feels the meeting would be a bit premature. Mr. Kraft feels similarly. Mr. Kraft will reach out to Mr. Rexroth's engineer. Council would like an idea of what is being proposed and in what municipality before meeting. Discussion continued.

The Stormwater Improvement schedule is being worked. It needs design review, pick projects. The grant funds must be spent by 2026.

Main Street CDBG - JVI - is almost up on the warranty phase. Councilman Sprenkle will send some photos to Mr. Kraft to see how they should be addressed.

Road Maintenance Plan - meeting was held the week of 6/31 with Kinsley. Kinsley does not have a firm date yet but would like to complete before school reconvenes in August.

Update on upcoming grants.

We received a forwarded complaint from PennDOT regarding the traffic light. PennDOT had instructed the individual to contact the Borough. The individual wanted the Borough to put in turning lanes. The Borough has not heard anything from the individual about this. Does Council want to consider a traffic study regarding timing. Discussion continued.

Sewer Billing

Solicitor's Report

Resolution 2025-05 appointing George Howett to the position of road master replacing Dustin Claycomb. Councilman Bankoske made the motion to resolve, seconded by Councilman Sprenkle. Councilman Howett abstained, all others in favor.

Resolution 2025-06 appointing Tim Ward to the vacant Council seat. Councilman Howett made a motion to resolve, seconded by Councilman Sprenkle. All in favor, so be it resolved. Councilman Snyder administered the oath of office.

Resolution 2025-07 modifying the intergovernmental cooperation agreement by the County of York and participating municipalities, by adjusting the criteria applicable to members of the County Board. Councilman Sprenkle made a motion to resolve, seconded by Councilman Howett. All in favor, so be it resolved.

Solicitor's Report Continued.

Resolution 2025-08 a resolution for submission to Pennsylvania Department of Community Development Authority for a multi-modal grant. Councilman Harper made a motion to resolve, seconded by Councilman Sprenkle. All in favor, motion carried.

Resolution 2025-09 a resolution extending our participation in the York County Regional Pollutant Reduction Plan through December 31, 2030. Councilman Howett made a motion to resolve, seconded by Councilman Sprenkle. All in favor, so be it resolved.

Solicitor Springer would like to attend a grant writing workshop hosted by PSAB in August. Council feels this would be a good idea.

The Mayor had asked Councilman Snyder to review the Emergency Action Plan. Councilman Snyder did review the plan, but this will require a resolution. The expectation is for Council review in August and a Resolution in September.

Maintenance Report

Councilman Howett has been cleaning a lot out at the dam.

There was a resident on E. Pennsylvania AVE who asked if they could park past the no parking sign due to limited parking. Discussion continued. Council opted not to remove the sign due to concerns about getting a fire truck being able to make the turn. Councilman Howett will try to come up with some alternatives.
